CSR Activities to be implemented during FY 2022-23:

1. Promoting research and studies related to Power Systems in the engineering institutions to encourage excellence in the area

As part of the efforts to strengthen Industry - Academia collaboration for exchange of knowledge and growth of Power System in the country, POSOCO has been conducting this activity as “POSOCO Power System Award (PPSA)” from 2013 onwards. Under this program, emerging and innovative research accomplishments in Power System and related fields are recognized through awards. The awards are given in two categories – at Master’s level and Doctoral level.

2. Design of prosthetic hand for below-elbow disabilities

The objective of this project is to develop a simple and affordable below- elbow prosthetic hand with adaptive grasp capability which will enable people to carry out their vital day-to-day activities.

3. Supply of Medial equipment and other healthcare Infrastructure items in Govt. hospital/Polyclinic/ Maternity home/ Maternity & Child Welfare Centre

This project aims to support the Govt. hospital/Polyclinic/ Maternity home/ Maternity & Child Welfare Centre in providing quality healthcare. As part of this project, work related with development of facilities for exclusive breast feeding corners/rooms for lactating mothers and emergency treatment rooms, providing medical equipment and strengthening of existing infrastructure is planned to be taken up.

4. Organizing camps for providing aids and assistive devices to Persons with Disabilities in one of the Aspirational Districts identified by NITI Aayog

To address the health care needs of persons with disabilities and contribute in their empowerment through provision of appropriate technology and rehabilitation services, POSOCO is taking up this activity under CSR. Various Aids and Assistive devices like Hearing Aid, Smart Cane, Wheel chair, Tricycle, Rollator, Walking Stick, Multi-Sensory Inclusive Educational Kit (MSIED) and Braille Slate etc. are planned to be distributed to the persons with Disabilities as a part of this activity.

5. Activities promoting Swachh Bharat Abhiyan/ Swasthya/Contribution to Swachh Bharat Kosh

POSOCO's aim towards this initiative is to ensure inclusive participation involving employees, the community and the under privileged while promoting the Swachh Bharat mission of the Govt. of India through various activities.

Programs like supply and installation of portable urinals/toilets, Water ATM's, Bio-Toilets, organic waste composters etc. are being taken up under this activity.

6. Annual Maintenance charges towards Water ATMs provided at Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi under CSR activity of FY 2019-20

With the aim to provide clean and safe drinking water to the patients visiting the hospital for treatment along with their attendants, 6 units of water ATMs were installed by POSOCO in Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi in the FY 2019-20. To ensure sustainability of the Water ATMs provided during FY 2019-20, AMC for the 3 years was also envisaged as part of project. The annual maintenance of Water ATM has been satisfactorily completed in FY 2021-22 and the same will be continued during FY 2022-23 also.

7. Capacity Building in the field of Computer education for effective utilization of the infrastructure created in the Govt. Schools in the FY 2017-18 under CSR including maintenance charges of infrastructure

Computer labs were set up by POSOCO in the two Govt. schools located in the vicinity of POSOCO office situated in Katwaria Sarai, New Delhi during FY 2017-18. Computers along with an Air Conditioner, an LED Screen and basic furniture etc. were provided in the lab of each school.

To ensure, infrastructure created in these schools is utilized effectively, capacity building in the field of computer education is being carried out by POSOCO from FY2018-19. This activity of capacity building is also being taken up during FY 2022-23.
